DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control ticks, fleas and lice on dogs, cats, puppies and kittens: Dilute 4 ounces of dip concentrate with 1 gallon of water.

As a dip: Dip animal into the solution. Make sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin, avoiding contact with eyes and mouth. Do not rinse after treatment. Towel or air dry.

As a sponge bath: Sponge solution on animal, making sure to thoroughly wet to the skin. Avoid contact with eyes and mouth. Do not rinse after treatment. Towel or air dry.

To control ear mites: Lightly sponge solution inside the animal's ears. Repeat as necessary to maintain control.

IMPORTANT: Do not treat puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age.

Storage: Store in a cool dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sunlight or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
