PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens, spray only along back or spray onto fingertips and rub into coat.

PETS SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present spray lightly into air. Repeat as needed. Pets bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed too. After spray has dried remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding.
