

For synthetic fibers, tumble mix INTERSEPT® with the polymeric resins or pellets at a level of 1-5% based on the total weight of the formulated resins or pellets, prior to extrusion. For nonwoven fabrics, mix INTERSEPT® directly into the polymeric binder at a level of 1-5% based on the total weight of the formulated binder. For topical treatment of woven, nonwoven and synthetic materials, expose fabric to a water emulsion containing INTERSEPT® at a 1-5% concentration and allow to dry.
