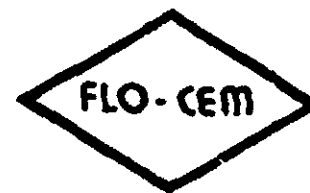
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
SUPER LD has been designed specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.

DISINFECTION: To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces such as walls, floors, linens, etc., use SUPER LD preparation of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let dry.

For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Pre-clean as recommended. Prepare a fresh solution.

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, etc., first add 2 ounces SUPER LD per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, sponge or mechanical sprayer. Wet the surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for reuse. Repeat application weekly until mold or mildew growth reappears.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye irritation. Do not get into eyes. If it does, flush with water for 15 minutes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Avoid contact with food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eye contact, flush with water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, consult a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing thoroughly with soap and water. If irritation persists, consult a physician. If these are not available, drink 2-4 ounces of water for each hour.

NOTE TO FARMERS:

Probable mucositis (inflammation of the lining of the mouth) and respiratory depression and irritation may be evident.
