FOR DOLLAR SPOT BROWN PATCH

Preventive Treatment: Symptoms occur throughout the season. Apply 1 to 2 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet.

Curative (Eradication): Apply 1 to 2 ounces of this product per 1,000 square feet. Repeat treatment at 3 to 4 week intervals. Preventive spray schedule.

FOR SNOW MOLD SPRAY APPLICATION: Apply 1 to 2 ounces of this product per 1,000 square feet of area. Repeat treatment at 3 to 4 week intervals. Preventive spray schedule.

Since it may not be possible to determine the amount of product that may be applied, apply 1 to 2 ounces per 1,000 square feet of area. Repeat treatment at 3 to 4 week intervals. Preventive spray schedule.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Thiram is a systemic fungicide which controls lawn diseases as well as being designed for the prevention and control of the diseases caused by fungi in the major turf grasses.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply as a liquid spray with hand sprayer, power sprayer, or a hose-on proportioner. Add the recommended amount of this product to the spray tank after one-half the required amount of water has been added. Agitate well and add second half of water. Keep agitator running to insure even suspension of this product in the water. Use spray mixture the same day it is prepared. Spray uniformly over the area to be treated, preferably after mowing. Allow spray mixture to dry on grass. Avoid mowing for at least 12 hours after application.

FOR DOLLAR SPOT, DAMPING OFF, GRAY LEAF SPOT, COPPER SPOT, BROWN PATCH AND MELTING OUT:

Preventive Treatment: Apply this product early in the Spring before disease begins to appear. It will require a schedule of 7 to 10 day intervals depending on the weather. Once disease is present, spray carefully into cracks in water to cover 1,000 square feet of turf area treated.

Curative Treatment: At the first sign of disease, apply 4 ounces of this product in 10 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet. Repeat treatments at 7 day intervals. When disease is under control, follow preventive spray schedule above.

FOR SNOW MOLD:

Spray Application: Apply this product immediately before the expected onset of snow, covering into 8 ounces in 10 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet of turf as possible. Make repeat applications following each snowfall at 10 ounces per 1,000 square feet of turf area.

Spreading Application: In areas where spraying is not possible due to freezing temperatures, this product may be applied with a spreader, composed of sand at the rate of 6 to 8 ounces per 1,000 square feet. Apply evenly spread over 1,000 square feet. Distribute evenly with a broadcast spreader or by hand with a mechanical spreader or by hand.

IMPORTANT: Do not use Thiram in combination with insecticides or herbicides. Do not use Thiram in combination with other fungicides.
