

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER**

Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May cause allergic skin reactions. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Remove and separately launder clothing before reuse.

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron.

AFTER WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

Statement of Practical Treatment

Captan-Methoxychlor 65-10 WP is a powder specially formulated for the planting to protect seed from molds and to protect seed from seed-borne and soil damping-off, and seedling blights. At the time of application, Captan-Methoxychlor 65-10 WP Seed Protectant and the germination of treated seed is not affected. The result is compared to results from untreated seed.

Read all directions before using and use only as specified on this label.

STIR CONTENTS THOROUGHLY INTO WATER BEFORE USE.

For SLURRY TREATMENT, apply in a slurry-type treater specifically designed and approved for that purpose or apply by hand in any suitable mixing equipment, such as home made rotary drums.

Thoroughly mix the recommended amount of this product into the required amount of water for the slurry treater equipment and dilution rate to be used. Clean equipment thoroughly between treating operations.

Only seed of high germination with good vigor should be treated with this product. Poor seed may suffer greater injury. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Store treated seed in a dry place until planted so that excess moisture will evaporate. If seed is stacked when wet, heat may develop which could impair germination.

IMPORTANT - Be certain treated seeds are completely dry before sacking or storing.

STORE ALL TREATED SEED IN A COOL, DRY PLACE.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for human consumption nor as animal feed. Bags containing treated seed should be labeled:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
