PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Statement of Practical Treatment

needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Store treated seed in a dry place until planted so that excess moisture will evaporate. If seed is stacked when wet, heat may develop which could impair germination.

IMPORTANT - Be certain treated seeds are completely dry before sacking or storing.
