

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)**

CAUTION

IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

IN CASE OF SKIN CONTACT: Wash the affected areas with soap and warm water.

Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash with soap and water after handling. Avoid inhaling of spray mist. Do not use or store near food or feed.

DIRECTIONS: Thoroughly mix the recommended amount of Captan-Methoxychlor 300-20 DD into the required amount of water for the slurry treater equipment and dilution rate to be used. Clean equipment thoroughly between treating operations.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for human consumption nor as animal feed. Bags containing treated seed should be labeled:

TREATED SEED

DO NOT USE FOR FEED, FOOD, OR OIL PURPOSES

THE Federal Government and some states have issued regulations for the application of special tags or labels to be affixed to bags containing treated seed.

Dispose of excess treated seed by burial.

PRODUCT INFORMATION:

Captan-Methoxychlor 300-20 DD is a liquid suspension especially formulated for the treatment of seed prior to storage and planting to protect seed from molds and other fungi causing storage loss and to protect seed from seed-borne and soil-borne fungi which cause seed decay, damping-off, and seedling blights. Also for protection of stored seed against Cadelle, confused flour beetle, flat grain beetle, granary weevil, lesser grain borer, red flour beetle, rice weevil, and saw-toothed beetle. At the recommended dosage Captan-Methoxychlor 300-20 DD is non-injurious to seeds or seedlings and the germination of treated seed is frequently stimulated, giving a superior result as compared to results from untreated seed. This product contains DOUBLE DYE as compared with Captan-Methoxychlor 300-20 Flowable Seed Protectant for applications where an extra-bright red seed coloring is desired.
