

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS
(AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)**

WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Do not breathe dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Causes eye and skin irritation. DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of State and Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions before using and use only as specified on this label.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. **MEASURING SCOOP IS ENCLOSED.** One level scoop holds approximately one ounce.

FOR IMPROVED MIXING OF PRODUCT WITH SEED. It is recommended that the seed be premixed in a suitable container with the product, then transferred to the planter box. Similar results may be obtained by filling the planter box half full of seed, then adding half the required amount of product, followed by thorough mixing with a stick and finally, the second half of seed and product, repeating the mixing.

IF SOIL TEMPERATURE IS EXTREMELY HIGH (hot weather, midsummer planting, or other reasons) reduce recommended dosage by one-third. Avoid lengthy storage of treated seed to prevent loss of Lindane.

MANEB - LINDANE PLANTER BOX SEED TREATER is a dust base agricultural insecticide and fungicide especially formulated for seed treatment at planting time. This product is formulated to help lubricate the planter box and assure a smooth, even flow to the furrow. It is formulated for use in the treatment of seeds for protection against wireworms, seed corn maggots, and certain other soil-borne insects as well as providing protection against sinking smut (bunt) of wheat, oat smuts, covered and false loose smuts of barley, and seed decay.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
