

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid inhaling of spray mist or dust. Do not use or store near food or feed.

During commercial exposure in seed treatment and loading operations, wear goggles, clean rubber gloves, protective clothing, and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health under provisions of 30 CFR, part 11.

Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Routinely shower or bathe after work; wash all clothing with soap and water before reusing.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increases the toxic effect of thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Exposed treated seeds may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from bodies of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place in an area designated for pesticides, and away from food or feed. Keep pesticide in original container. Keep container firmly closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a Physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth.

This product is recommended for the treatment of listed seeds and will usually increase stands and yields by reducing loss from seed diseases. It also will usually control loose and covered seed-borne fungi, verticillium and decay of gladiolus bulbs.

DIRECTIONS

This product should be mixed with the required amount of water and may be applied dry, if desired.

Rotary Drum or Small Container: Fill unit not more than 1/2 full of product, rotate slowly until product is evenly distributed on all seeds.

Slurry Treaters: Thoroughly mix the required amount of product with amount of water for the slurry treater equipment and distribute evenly, thoroughly, between treating operations.

Planter or Drill Box: Place in the total amount of seed and mix thoroughly. Add an amount of seed and product and mix as above.

Treat peanuts promptly after shelling. Other seeds may be treated after curing.

Gladiolus Bulbs: Treat anytime after drying. Dip bulbs in a slurry product in 6 gallons of water. Agitate suspension frequently, then allow to dry.

GLADIOLUS RULES that are treated with this product must be handled in a way that instructs: **CAUTION:** Treated with thiram. Protective clothing when handling products treated with thiram. Exposure to skin may result in severe dermatitis.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with seed for which those seeds needed for immediate use. Informing the user that store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. Seed commercial, treat in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. Label.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed. Treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Dispose of a slurry by burial away from bodies of water.
