

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS,

CAUTION**

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is recommended for the treatment of listed seeds to increase stands and yields by reducing loss from seed decay. It usually controls the loose and covered kernel smut of sorghum.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AS A SEED TREATMENT: This product should be applied with a treater designed and approved for this purpose, or may be applied by such as home-made rotary drums. Seed may be treated anytime a FLOWABLE/TYPE TREATMENT. Use by mixing with water in a slurry for the type of slurry equipment being used and the seed being treated. **FOR HAND-SLURRY TREATMENT:** Consult the following table for amount of each 100 pounds of seed. Add this amount to 1 pint of slurry suspension. Place seed in a mixing container or spread in a cloth or paper. Sprinkle the measured amount of slurry suspension maximally. Turn seed at least 5 times and allow to dry before use. **IMPORTANT:** Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with for. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the inventory. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. Seed containers be labeled in accord with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with for. Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wild and seed packaging by burial away from bodies of water.

It may be applied to well-cured rice seed prior to pre-plant soaking suspension in treaters suitable for adequate mixing and accurate application. **NOTE:** To prevent water contamination in irrigation or drainage canals, selling basins. Do not use treated seed for food or feed.
