DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. **PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a Physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth.
