

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

Statement of Practical Treatment

GENERAL INFORMATION

THREE-WAY PLANTER BOX SEED TREATER is a dust base agricultural planter box treatment for protection of listed seeds against seed corn beetles, seed corn maggots, wireworms, and seed-borne and soil borne fungi which cause seed decay, damping-off, and seedling blights. This product is formulated with a non-oil lubricant to help lubricate the planter box and assure a smooth, even seed flow to the furrow. MEASURING SCOOP IS ENCLOSED. One level scoop holds approximately 1 oz. of product.

BEST DOCUMENT AVAILABLE

Applicators who apply this product manually or without the use of a closed-system treatment procedure must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: long-sleeved shirt; long pants; gloves; and a disposable, paper dust mask which covers at least one-third of the face.

This product should be applied in a well-ventilated area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read all directions and use only as specified on this label. Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time.

Planter Box Treatment:

Beans, Corn, Peas, Sorghum, Soybeans — Use 2½ - 3½ ounces per bushel of seed as a dry mixture in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting.

FOR IMPROVED MIXING OF PRODUCT WITH SEED, it is recommended that the seed be pre-mixed in a suitable container with the product, then transferred to the planter box. Similar results may be obtained by filling the planter box half full of seed, then adding half the required amount of product, followed by thorough mixing with a stick and finally, the second half of the seed and product, repeating the mixing. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.

NOTE: Do not use on seed already treated with an insecticide except Malathion or Methoxychlor used for control of stored grain insects.

Your Application Dated November 23, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add "or convulsing" between "unconscious" and "person" in the "If Swallowed" advice.
2. Change the second sentence of the "If in eyes" advice to read: "Call a physician immediately."
3. Add "Diazinon" in front of the diazinon formula name in the ingredients statement.
4. Revise the Pesticide Disposal statement to read:

Pesticides wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray material, or mixtures is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by the applicant in full accordance with instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the nearest hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

5. "Hazard Precautions" and "First Aid" should be revised to read:
