

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

## DANGER

Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. May cause allergic skin reactions. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. ## USE PRECAUTION STATEMENTS

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse.

Mixers/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron.

AFTER WORK: Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. ## GENERAL INFORMATION

THREE-WAY PLANTER BOX SEED TREATMENT for protection of seed from beetles, seed corn maggots, wireworms, fungi which cause seed decay, damping off. This product is formulated with a non-oil lubricant to assure a smooth, even application.

## DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product without its labeling.

**FOR IMPROVED MIXING OF PRODUCT WITH SEED:** With the seed in any commercial or barre for PLANTER BOX method, fill the barre with the required amount of product and mix the remainder of the seed to the barre and add product to the seed, again mixing thoroughly.

## Planter Box Treatment:

Beans, Corn, Peas, Soybeans  
bushel of seed as a dry mixture in the planter prior to planting.

**NOTE:** Do not use on seed already treated with Malathion or Methoxychlor used for control of insects.

## SEED TREATMENT: DO NOT USE TREATED SEED

Treated seed should be labelled in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Seed Act. Treated seed must be stored in a container that is labeled with the natural color to the seed if the interstate commerce. Labels attached to treated seed must not be used for "Exposed treated seed may be hazardous." In the event that treated seeds are spilled, completely cover them with soil away from water.

Only seed of high germination with good vigor. Poor seed may suffer greater loss for immediate use, minimizing the loss of treated seed in a dry place until evaporation. If seed is stacked when wet germination.

Store all treated seed in a safe place.
