MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

With agitation add water until sprayer tank is well covered. When done, dilute to desired concentration. When using this product as directed on this label, add the first. Then with agitator running, add the product and finish mixing with water. Continue agitation to insure good emulsification.

Do not use if this spray does not emulsify. Correct emulsification is indicated if when this product is added to water in the tank, a uniform, milky white spray mixture results during agitation. If the spray mixture after adding this product under agitation is not milky, white, do not use the resulting spray or the remainder of this product. To test for correct emulsification, add a small amount of this product to water in a mixer before wettable powders or other insecticides or fungicides are added.

AMOUNTS GIVEN FOR 100 GALLONS OF DILUTED SPRAY
ALFALFA (SEED CROP ONLY): Use 1 quart per acre in 20 to 30 gallons water by ground applicator or 10 to 15 gallons water by air when used in combination and at the recommended rates with either CYTHIONIL or Toxaphene for control of pests listed on the product label. For Spider Mites, use 1 quart per acre at the rate indicated above with Kerthran at the recommended label rates.
