## GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is registered for use on turf and lawns as a fungicide for the prevention and control of most of the common fungus diseases on turfgrasses.

## HOW TO APPLY

Apply as a foliar spray with hand sprayer, power sprayer, or a hose-end proportioner. Add the recommended amount of this product to the spray tank after one-half the recommended amount of water has been added. Add the remaining half of water. Keep agitator running to insure even suspension of this product in the water. Use spray mixture the same day it is prepared. Spray or pour evenly over the area to be treated, preferably after mowing. Allow spray mixture to dry on grass. Do not water for 24 hours. Avoid mowing for at least 24 hours after application.

### FOR DOLLAR SPOT, FADING-OUT, GRAY LEAF SPOT, COPPER SPOT, BROWN PATCH, MELTING OUT, POWDERY MILDEW, AND RUST:

**Preventive Treatment:** Apply this product early in the Spring before disease symptoms occur, then follow a regular schedule at 7 to 10 day intervals throughout the season. Use 2 ounces of this product in 5 gallons of water for each 1,000 square feet of turf area treated.

**Curative (Eradicative) Treatment:** At the first sign of disease, apply 4 ounces of this product in 5 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet. Repeat treatment at 3 to 5-day intervals. When disease is controlled, follow preventive spray schedule above.

### FOR SNOW MOLD:

**Spray Application:** Apply this product immediately before the expected permanent snow cover, using 6 to 8 ounces in 5 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet of turf. If possible, make repeat applications following each thaw using 3 ounces per 1,000 square feet of turf area.

Since it may not be possible to spray due to freezing temperatures, this product may be mixed with screened compost or sand at the rate of 6 to 8 ounces in 10 quarts and evenly spread over 1,000 square feet. Distribute over the tree evenly in two directions with a mechanical spreader, if hand.

**IMPORTANT:** This product may be applied with most insecticides commonly used on grasses. Do not use or mix with chloroane or alkaline materials such as lime.
