Use this product to control Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths), Armyworms, Ants, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Pillbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, and Fleas on Home Lawns and Other Ornamental Turf Areas. Mix with water according to directions given in the following table and apply uniformly as a coarse (Large droplet) spray, using a low pressure sprayer.

Alternate application chart for small areas:

30 sq ft	4 teaspoons	1 gallon
60 sq ft	8 teaspoons	2 gallon
120 sq ft	16 teaspoons	4 gallon

Make first treatment when insects first appear and retreat as necessary. Lawn should be moist at time of application. Thoroughly water immediately after treatment to wash the insecticide into the turf. However, for sod webworms delay watering or mowing the treated area for 12 to 24 hours after treatment.

CAUTION: Keep children and pets off treated areas until the spray has dried.
