DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of State and Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions before using and use only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS: Thoroughly mix the recommended amount of this product into the required amount of water for the slurry treater equipment and dilution rate to be used. Clean equipment thoroughly between treating operations. Store all treated seed in a cool, dry place.

IMPORTANT: Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. Seed commercially treated with this product must be labeled in accord with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. Labels attached to treated seed must state: "Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil, and exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Dispose of all excess treated seed and seed packaging by burial away from bodies of water."

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. **APPLICATIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not empty containers.
2. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide sprays, mixtures, or sludges that cannot be used as directed, must be disposed of according to Federal, State, or local procedures. Refer to Agency Conservation and Recovery Act.

This product is an emulsifiable concentrate of Lindane containing dye for seed treatment purposes. Use at dosage rates indicated below. **IMPORTANT** - Be certain treated seed are completely dry before sacking or storing.

ONLY SEED OF HIGH GERMINATION with good vigor should be treated with Lindane. Poor seed may suffer greater injury. It is suggested that seed be treated not over six weeks before planting. What effect prolonged storage has on germination has not been definitely established. Treated seed should be stored in a dry place until planted so that excess moisture may evaporate. If seed is stacked when wet, mold may develop which impairs germination.

IF SOIL TEMPERATURE IS EXTREMELY HIGH (hot weather, mid summer planting or other reasons) reduce recommended dosage by one half. Where seed decay occurs due to soil organisms combine with a protective fungicide.

Do not use in poorly ventilated areas. Do not use in areas where food is stored. Do not use in areas where food is prepared. Do not use in areas where food is consumed. Do not use in areas where food is stored, prepared, or consumed.
