NOTE: Do not mix with fertilizer or other lawn care products. Check your set spreader settings before treating your lawn.

For control of certain white grub species (larvae of European spruce sawfly and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amount of product shown in the table above. Use 2 to 4 lbs per 1000 sq ft. Apply to lawn areas in home lawns and ornamentals to be treated. Mix and apply immediately by thorough watering. For best results, treat when grubs are young and are very fresh on the soil surface. Apply during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

For control of hyperodes (hortgrass) weevils use two to four times the rate of product shown in the table above. Apply to lawn areas in home lawns and ornamentals to be treated. Mix and apply immediately by thorough watering. Consult your local Agricultural Extension specialist for proper time to treat in your area.
