The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Propiconazole RED** and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated May 9, 2012

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. For formulation into end use product for the following uses:

Wood Preservation

- Wood preservatives and wood preservative stain products; specifically logs, lumber and wood products for sapstain control, engineered wood composite products, and wood chips.

Material Preservation

- In container preservative caulks, sealants, adhesives, inks, coatings, and paints
- Metal Working fluids
- Dry film preservative of coatings and building materials
- Non-food contact paper and paperboard products, wallboard (drywall and gypsum board), ceiling tiles, rubber and plastic products, leather (wet leather stock such as pickled, vegetable-, chrome-, alternative metal or metal free tanned hides and skins) and textiles (shower curtains, carpet backing, awnings, boat covers, canvas, cordage, tents, tarpaulins, and wall coverings).

This product may not be formulated into an in-can preservative for stains unless the maximum concentration of propiconazole is less than or equal to 0.15% by weight.

Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
