DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To prevent wood rot and decay and to control adhesion and penetration of mushroom mycelium in timber trays and benches add 19.5 fl. oz. of SAFETRAYTM P to 25 gal. of water to achieve a treating concentration of 1,500 ppm active ingredient.

MIXING

Half-fill the spray tank with water. Add the appropriate amount of SAFETRAYTM P. Triple rinse empty container and add the rinsate to the tank. Stir gently and add water up to the required volume. A few drops of an antifoam agent may be added to avoid excessive foaming.
