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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. **Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.**

HANDLER PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- When mixing, loading, or applying pesticide, and for routine cleaning or maintenance of equipment, wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield or safety glasses), protective clothing (long sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, and safety shoes), chemical resistant gloves such as natural rubber, polyethylene or PVC and a dust filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P, or HE filter. 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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. BETHOGUARD is to be incorporated into the following materials at suitable stages of the manufacturing process to preserve the integrity of the manufactured/treated materials. Not for use in food grade paper, paperboard, paper coatings and adhesives.

Not for use in textiles used for clothing articles.

TYPES OF MATERIALS:

Plastics (including films, foams, laminates, molded parts, pellets, sheets) such as Polyethylene, polypropylene, polyester; polyvinyl alcohol, epoxy resin, phenolic resin, polycarbonate, acetate, polystyrene, polyurethane, acrylic, etc.

Textiles & Fibers/Fabrics (including multi-fiber blends and synthetic blends with natural fibers) such as: acetate, acrylic, cotton, nylon, polyester, polyethylene, polypropylene, polyvinylchloride, rayon, wool, and coating/finishes applied to such materials

Building Materials including adhesives, caulks, grouts, gel coats, glazing compounds, sealants, patching compounds, dry wall, gypsum, pearlite, plaster-like or mineral based materials, paper & paperboard (non-food contact),

APPLICATIONS

Manufactured materials may be used in the following end-use applications such that the finished product contains 0.10% to 1.0% by weight of the active ingredient:

<u>Plastics, thermoset and thermoplastic resins:</u> Carpet backings, foam underlay for carpets, synthetic non-leather materials, foam stuffing for cushions and mattresses, wire and cable insulation, wall coverings, covers or ticking, gaskets, weather stripping, boat covers, tents, tarpaulins, awnings, refuse containers, bath mats/appliqués, sponge or fiber mops, toilet brush receptacles, soap dish holders, boating & marine equipment, bags (blanket, garbage, garment, vacuum), curtains (window, shower, cubicle), liners (garbage, trays), humidifier components, appliance housings, automotive interiors, brooms, bristles & handles of brushes (non-medical), combs, buckets, carts.

Textiles & Fibers/Fabric: Tents, tarpaulins, awnings, shower curtains, curtains (window, shower, cubicle).

<u>Building Materials (non-food contact)</u>: including adhesives, caulks (including tub & tile), grouts, gel coats, sealants, patching compounds, dry wall, gypsum, pearlite, plaster-like or mineral based materials, paper & paperboard for insulation wallboard, and wall coverings, bathtubs and bathtub enclosures, flooring (concrete, epoxy, component fibers, vinyl, linoleum & coatings), handles & knobs, whirlpools, shower stalls, tile, ceiling tile, walls, wall coverings, partitions, toilets and toilet components/accessories.

Specific manufacturing directions for a given application will be provided by consultation with Janssen PMP.



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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place in original container. Do not use or store near heat or open flames. Protect product from direct sunlight.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment, and then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and Local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

Clean up spills immediately. Cover the pesticide powder with absorbent material, such as dry sand, sawdust or earth. Collect spill by sweeping or shoveling into an appropriate waste disposal container. Dispose of waste in a manner approved by Local authorities.
