On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

- c. Revise the first aid statement and its heading to read as follows:

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 1-20 minutes. Call Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

In case of emergency call (insert toll-free emergency number).

Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor or going in for treatment.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

The following statements are suggested types of information that may be included, if applicable:

- medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;

- Socks and shoes
- Chemical-resistant gloves (such as: Barrier Laminate, or any of the following gloves at \geq 14 mils thickness: butyl nitrile, neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride or Viton).
- Goggles or face shield.

- f. Add the following User Safety Requirements and Recommendations:

"Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."

"User Safety Recommendations"

"Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet."

"Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing." User should remove personnel protective equipment immediately after handling this product. Wash outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible wash thoroughly.

- g. Revise the precautionary the statement to read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
WARNING

Causes skin irritation and moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

4. Submit three (3) copies of the final printed label prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
