ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is a finely divided powder which combines the flushing and killing powers of pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide with the dehydrative principle of thymol. It is relatively odorless and non-staining and may be used in accordance with directions in homes, restaurants, stores, hotels, offices, plants, warehouses, truck trailers and railroad cars. When used as directed, it is highly effective in controlling such insects as ants, roaches, silverfish, bed bugs, fleas, lice, ticks, bees, wasps and dry termites.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Open dumping is prohibited.
- Do not reuse empty container.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved

for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

4. GENERAL

Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

NON FOOD AREAS:

Food processing plants and warehouses, bakeries, beverage plants, restaurants, homes, institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, motels, theaters, schools, truck trailers and railroad cars, supermarkets, meat and poultry processing plants. To control such running and crawling insect life as ants, cockroaches, silverfish and fleas in animal quarters, distribute RONCO EXTERMINATOR at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square feet surface area. Apply a continuous visible film underneath and behind stoves, refrigerators and appliances. Treat on, around and behind moldings, shelving, baseboards, pipe openings, cracks, crevices, and other areas where insects may hide. For severe infestations, apply RONCO EXTERMINATOR behind cabinets and walls, in crawl spaces and attics at the rate of 16 ounces per 1,000 square feet of surface area. Repeat treatment as necessary.

DO NOT USE IN THE EDIBLE PRODUCT AREAS OF FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, RESTAURANTS, OR OTHER AREAS WHERE FOOD IS COMMERCIALY PREPARED OR PROCESSED. DO NOT USE IN FOOD AREAS WHILE FOOD IS EXPOSED.

SEWER TREATMENTS:

American and Oriental cockroach infestations in sanitary sewers may be treated with approximately 6 ounces of RONCO EXTERMINATOR per manhole. When treating sewers, one manhole per 200 feet of line should be

treated. Treatments are made by removing the manhole cover and replacing with a disc of plywood bored to receive the usual flexible hose from portable or truck mounted ventilating equipment. 6 ounces of RONCO EXTERMINATOR is introduced into the ventilating air to be dispersed quickly and thoroughly through the system.

BEDBUGS:

Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If hollow, such as square or round tubing, see that the interior of framework is well dusted. Mattresses should be dusted, especially tufts, folds and edges. Picture frame moldings and all cracks and crevices in the room should be treated.

DRY WOOD TERMITES:

These termites are restricted to certain parts of the country and should not be confused with Subterranean termites. Use an electric or hand operated rotary duster to distribute RONCO EXTERMINATOR through an entry, e.g. crawl hole into the attic and the crawl space of the building. Rate of application is recommended at one (1) pound per 1,000 square feet of floor area. All wood surfaces must be covered. All vents and louvers on the windward side to be closed.

FLEAS:

Dogs and cats. Liberally apply powder to the animal, rubbing thoroughly to the skin. Begin with the neck and include the underbody, legs, feet, and the base of the tail. Repeat as necessary. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at rate of one ounce per 50 square feet. Heavily infested lawns, basements and crawl spaces should be dusted at rate of 16 ounces per 1,000 square feet. Repeat as necessary.
