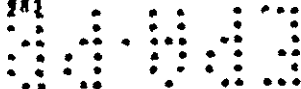

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NET CONTENTS: _____

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The use of this product in food processing establishments should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Processing surfaces should be covered during treatment. Surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned and rinsed with potable water. Stored food products which are infested should be treated by other effective methods using an application method intended for that purpose.

SPACE SPRAY: For control of accessible, exposed areas including fruit flies, mosquitoes, small flying wasps, hornets, cheese skippers and these common pests: granary weevils, rice weevils, confused saw-toothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigar beetle, drugstore beetles, Angoumois grain moths, Mediterranean mealworms, Indian meal moths, tobacco moths, mealworms, mites. Close windows and doors and shut off ventilation. Use a fogger or vaporizer adjusted to deliver a fine mist (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 80 microns). Apply at the rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct the spray toward the ceiling and the area and behind obstructions. For best control of hornets, apply directly to nests in the evening when the hornets have returned to the nests. Vacate the treated area before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

SPACE AND CONTACT SPRAY: For control of accessible areas including silverfish, crickets, cockroaches, spiders, mites, cheese mites, earwigs and ants, first use a contact spray. Then use a space spray. The contact spray can deliver a pin spray, direct spray into all cracks and crevices, in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, etc. In all places where these insects are known to seek refuge, spray as many insects as possible, spray directly at the insects. Do not allow spray to contact stored food. Then, close doors and ventilating systems, proceed with space spray at the rate as given above. Use a dosage rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep the area closed for at least 24 hours. Vacate the treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES:

Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

CAUTION

After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and all other food processing plants wash all equipment with potable water (benches, shelving, etc.), where exposed food will be handled. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
