Dip cuttings to the desired rooting depth when placed in propagation media.

General Dilutions

Softwood or herbaceous cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 20 parts water.

Medium hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 10 parts water.

Hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 5 parts water.
