Dip cuttings to the desired rooting depth then place in propagation media.

General Dilution's

- Softwood or herbaceous cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 20 parts water.
- Medium hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 10 parts water.
- Hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's Rooting Compound to 5 parts water.

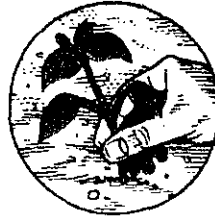

FIRST AID
