Dear Mr. Kennedy:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, to provide a revised label which adds the missing "Environmental Hazards" section, and intended use sites, is acceptable providing you send a final printed label within 30 days from the date of this letter which makes the following changes.

1. Change the second sentence to state "This product is for use in Green Houses, Nurseries, Shade Houses, Lath Houses, and by Homeowners".
2. In the "Environmental Hazards" section, delete the last two sentences beginning with "Applying this product", and ending with "...or damage system", and replace with "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate".
3. In the "Notice to Buyer", change the second sentence to state, "To the extent consistent with applicable law, user assumes all risks, if use, storage or handling is not in strict accordance with accompanying directions".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal laws to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for use in Green Houses, Nurseries, Lath Houses and Homeowners.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Dip cuttings to the desired rooting depth then place in propagation media.

General Dilutions

Softwood or herbaceous cuttings - 1 part Wood's to 20 parts water.

Medium hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's to 10 parts water.

Hardwood cuttings - 1 part Wood's to 5 parts water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over treated areas will help avoid run off to water bodies or damage system.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS
