### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**To Use:** Remove one mat from its protective wrapping and slide it in under the grill on top of ceramic plate. Then plug unit directly into standard household wall outlet or UL approved extension cord. Mat may be left in place and used repeatedly for up to 8 hours. Mat's blue indicator color changes to white when repellent in mat has been exhausted. Slip in a fresh mat, pushing out the old mat with the new one. Do not use in rooms while people are sleeping. Do not leave unit unattended while plugged in.

Use one unit for each 1,200 cu. ft. of space (a room approximately 10' x 14' x 9'). Use only Spira Mats in unit.
