- e. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- 3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** Remove children and pets from area until  
treatment has been completed. Do not treat pets with this product. This  
product is not recommended for households with crawling infants. Avoid  
contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental  
plants. Do not allow children to apply this product.

**CARPETS:** Thoroughly vacuum or clean carpets before use. If adult fleas  
are present, use EPA registered foggers or carpet spray. Apply powder to dry  
carpets only. Apply directly to areas where pets frequent or sleep at the rate  
of one pound per 200 square feet. Work product into base of carpet with  
broom or wooden rake. Remove visible powder on carpet surface with  
vacuum. Allow 2-4 weeks for maximum control.

**UPHOLSTERY:** Remove loose cushions. Apply along seams, in cracks and  
corners. Do not apply to exposed areas. Remove any visible product after  
application with vacuum.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in original  
container in a dry place away from children and pets.

**DISPOSAL:** DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER. Rinse three times with water and  
recycle if available. If not recycled, puncture and dispose in sanitary landfill.  
Incinerate if allowed by local laws. If burned, avoid breathing smoke.
