- d. Revise the Disposal statement to read as follows: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
- e. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows: Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.
- f. You must add a Statement of Practical Treatment (or First Aid) to read as follows:
If Swallowed: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.

N-Octyl Bicycloheptene dicarboximide 1.1%;
upper limit 1.16%; lower limit 1.05%.

The certified limits for the petroleum distillate Vista LPA are as follows: upper limit 91.67%; lower limit 86.33%.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Bathe pet with a quality cleansing shampoo. Dilute 4 ounces of Dip Concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse off. Repeat as necessary for control.

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.

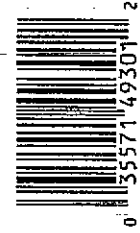
