

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not allow contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, or seeds. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Do not apply, allow to drift, or drain or flush equipment onto or near crop lands, lawns, trees, or other desirable plants or areas where their roots may extend. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

USE DIRECTIONS

VEGAT-OX LWK-C2 is a selective herbicide for control of weeds and grasses in non-crop areas. It is used on lawns, driveways, parking lots, storage yards, and industrial areas where a weed-free soil surface is desired. This product kills most young weeds and grasses by contact and deposits a chemical residue on the soil. The residue prevents annual weeds and grass seeds from growing during the entire growing season. Activity will be apparent in a few days. Final kill by root penetration may take from 2 to 4 weeks. The effectiveness and length of time that control will last will depend on the amount of rain, and other conditions.

For best results apply VEGAT-OX LWK-C2 to weeds germinating or a few weeks old. Under extreme conditions a second application may be necessary. Application may be made after top growth has started, but better control will be obtained if applied before short or when excessive growth has started before applying.

For driveways, gravelled areas, parking lots and storage yards: Mix 1 quart weed killer with 2 gallons of water and apply evenly over 125 sq. ft. Use a sprinkling can or coarse sprayer to thoroughly wet all foliage.

For areas where heavy grass and weed growth is present such as fence rows and fire lanes and where vegetation is more than 18 inches high: Apply 1 quart in 5 to 8 gallons of water per 125 sq. ft. Under conditions where weeds are difficult to control, increase the rate of application to 2 to 3 quarts in 4 gallons of water per 125 sq. ft.

Do not use this product on lawns. Do not apply over root zones of valuable trees, shrubs, or woody ornamental plants.

DO NOT permit this product to contact in any manner cotton, grapes, fruit trees, vegetables, flowers, ornamentals or other desirable plants, either in the growing or dormant periods. Under certain conditions vapors of this product may injure susceptible plants growing in areas near treated fields; therefore, use only where there is no chance of injury from such vapors.

NOTE: DO NOT apply, allow to drift or drain or flush equipment onto or near croplands, lawns, trees or other desirable plants or to areas where roots may extend. DO NOT allow contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides or seeds.
