In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 43960-5".
- b. Include the heading "Net Contents".
- c. Delete the colon (:) which is next to the word: Danger
- d. The signal word: "Danger" should be placed directly below the word: "reach". (center panel only).

- d. Delete the word: "the" in the statement "Keep Out Of Reach of Children."
- e. Just a reminder to check the type size requirements for the front panel precautionary statements. Based upon the label submitted, it should be at least 18 points for the signal word and 12 points for the child hazard statement.
- f. The headings: "Precautionary Statements" and "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" are considered two separate label elements and should be displayed as such on the label.
- g. Delete the word: "Long lasting"
- h. Revise the statement: "Do not get in eyes or on skin" to read: "Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing."
- i. Revise the statement: "Wash contaminated clothing before reuse" to read: "Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."
- j. Add a front panel descriptor to read:

A Metal Working Fluid Microbiocide

- k. Include in the "Make-up fluid section" the following additional directions:

- frequency of dosage
- frequency of when system should be cleaned.

- l. Include in the first paragraph of the use directions the following statement:

A microbiocide is for use in the manufacture of metal working fluids and/or for use in existing systems which use metal working fluids

- m. Revise the statement: "...as a preservative in industrial products..." to read "...to control and/or inhibit the growth of bacteria and/or fungi in industrial products..."

- n. Add the following statement to the dilution section of the directions:

"This dilution provides about 800-1100 ppm active"

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTicide DISPOSAL:

Pesticide spray mixture or waste water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Surcide P has been designed as a preservative in industrial products such as soluble emulsion, semi-synthetic and synthetic curing fluids, hydraulic fluids and chemical coolants. Surcide P can be added with minor agitation directly to the concentrate or the make-up fluid. In both instances the final concentration of Surcide P should be 0.10 - 0.15%.

ADDITION RATES

CONCENTRATE

Add Surcide P to the concentrate to result in 0.10-0.15% in the final use dilution (add 0.8 - 1.2 pints per 100 gallons of diluted fluid).

MAKE-UP FLUID (DILUTED FLUID)

Add Surcide P directly to the make-up fluid (diluted fluid) to result in a concentration of 0.10 - 0.15% (add 0.8-1.2 pints per 100 gallons of diluted fluid).

For best results drain and clean the system before adding fresh cutting fluid.
