Amendment Dated July 28, 1994

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, sec. 3(c)(7)(A) to include the additional uses on the product label, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. On the front panel, delete the description statement "For Use In Metal Working And Other Preservative Applications" to "A Metal Working Fluid Microbiocide".

b. Include in the first paragraph of the use directions the following statement:

A microbiocide is for use in the manufacture of metal working fluids and/or for use in existing systems which use metal working fluids.

c. Delete the colon (:) which is next to the word "Danger"

- d. Revise the section on Industrial and Household Emulsions to read:

**Commercial and Industrial Preservative.**

For the preservation of laundry detergents, floor finishes, floor cleaners, window cleaners, printing inks, detergent solutions (not intended to come in contact with food), glues and adhesives (for non-food use applications only), starch suspensions used to make boxes (for non-food use applications only).

To control microbial spoilage, add Surcide P directly to the manufacturing batch with minor agitation to result in a final concentration of 0.05 - 0.20% (add 0.4 - 1.8 pints per 100 gallons of product). This dilution provides 400 - 1550 ppm active Surcide P.

- 2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

## **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

### **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### METAL WORKING

Surcide P has been designed to control and/or inhibit the growth of bacteria and/or fungi in industrial products such as soluble emulsion, semi-synthetic and synthetic cutting fluids, hydraulic fluids and chemical coolants. Surcide P can be added with minor agitation directly to the concentrate or the make-up fluid. In both instances the final concentration of Surcide P should be 0.10 - 0.15%.

#### ADDITION RATES CONCENTRATE

Add Surcide P to the concentrate to result in 0.10-0.15% in the final use dilution (add 0.8 - 1.2 pints per 100 gallons of diluted fluid). This dilution provides 800-1100 ppm active.

#### MAKE-UP FLUID (DILUTED FLUID)

Add Surcide P directly to the make-up fluid (diluted fluid) to result in a concentration of 0.10 - 0.15% (add 0.8-1.2 pints per 100 gallons of diluted fluid). Redose every 4-6 weeks or when the system emits foul odors.

For best results drain and clean the system before adding fresh cutting fluid, or when the cutting fluid fails (split emulsion).

#### INDUSTRIAL AND HOUSEHOLD EMULSIONS, \*ADHESIVES, \*INKS, \*CORRUGATED STARCH SUSPENSIONS AND SURFACTANT PRODUCTS

To control microbial spoilage, add Surcide P directly to the manufacturing batch with minor agitation to result in a final concentration of 0.05-0.20% (add 0.4-1.8 pints per 100 gallons of products). This dilution provides 400-1550ppm active Surcide P.
