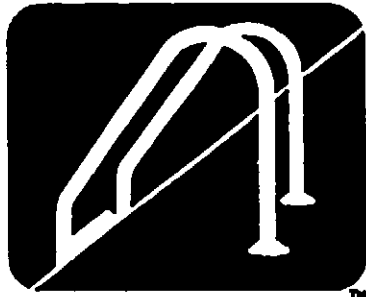

### WHY To Use This Product

When algae infect a pool, the water looks murky and greenish, and chlorine demand is high. VINYL POOL ALGAE KILLER is effective in killing most types of algae and is safe for fiberglass or colored plaster pools. To kill mustard algae, POOL TIME recommends MUSTARD ALGAE KILLER. To kill algae in white plaster pools, POOL TIME recommends WHITE PLASTER ALGAE KILLER.

### HOW To Use This Product

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL APPLICATION:** BEFORE using this product, shut off pump and ventilate pool. Wait 4 hours for water to become stationary. Pre-dissolve VINYL POOL ALGAE KILLER in a clean, plastic container of water using dosage directions below. Stir with a plastic spoon. Do not add any other chemicals or materials to the bucket. Add to pool at night (or when pool is not in use) along edges of the pool. AFTER 24 hours, then turn pump on and remove dead algae from pool surfaces with a vacuum. Clean filter. If living algae are still visible, repeat treatment. DO NOT USE if residual falls below 3.0 ppm as determined by a test kit.

**DOSAGE DIRECTIONS:** Use 2 pounds of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water to heavy algae growth. Use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons for light algae growth. Use product, NEVER add more than 1 pound of VINYL POOL ALGAE KILLER per 20,000 gallons at one time. If more treatment is needed, re-fill container and pre-dissolve again.

### How to Determine Pool Capacity

Shape of Pool ..... Compute Total Gallons of Water By Method Below  
Rectangle ..... Length x Width x Average Depth x 7.5  
Round ..... Diameter x Diameter x Average Depth x 7.5  
Oval ..... Long Diameter x Short Diameter x Average Depth x 7.5  
Irregular ..... Consult with pool builder

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep product dry in original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from fire. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before decarding this container. Do not reuse empty container in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal of equipment.
