It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS

USE ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA.
REMOVE BIRDS AND COVER AQUARIUMS BEFORE SPRAYING.
REMOVE CAP AND INSERT SPRAYER.

CATS AND DOGS: Cover animals eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke, to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With finger tips rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs and cats, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

To control spinose ear ticks and ear mites, apply 10 drops of FLEA & TICK KILLER to each ear so that it can penetrate the wax down to the surrounding tissues. Repeat treatment once or twice at 2 to 3 day intervals as necessary.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub into coat. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into air. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results.

HORSES AND PONIES: To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies apply to face, legs, flanks, topline and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
