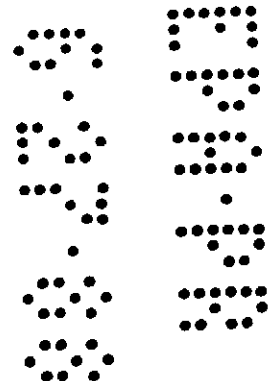

BACK PANEL - ARC Laboratories' Flea & Tick Killer

Temporarily repels gnats, mosquitoes and biting flies. Contains a grooming agent to ease combing and brushing to remove dead fleas, ticks and lice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only in a well ventilated area. Remove birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

DOGS AND CATS: Cover animals eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke. to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With finger tips rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs and cats, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed. **PUPPIES AND KITTENS:** Spray only along back or on your finger tips and rub into coat. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (inaccessible to children and pets) and away from heat or open flame. Protect from freezing. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection.

DOGS AND CATS: Comb hair thoroughly with a flea comb and with a fine-toothed comb. Apply a proper spray amount to the back and chest until the hair is damp. Rub into face around the eyes. Then spray the quarters, finishing with penetration of spray against the hair. On long-haired animals, rub your hand against the back spraying the ruff. Rub the hand. Thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat as needed.

To control spring mites, apply 10-15 minutes that it can penetrate rounding tissues. Repeat or twice at 2-3 days.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Apply to back or on your feet. Do not use on puppies under 4 weeks of age.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray baseboards, window cracks and local areas as needed. Then spray and the bedding for best results.

HORSES AND PONIES: Apply to horse flies, horse fly bites. Apply to face line and other areas attacked by these flies as needed.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. Protect from freezing. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection.
