DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

Add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools Chlorinating Solution to each 10,000 gallons of water. For swimming pools, add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools Chlorinating Solution per 10,000 gallons of water.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

Add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools Chlorinating Solution to each 10,000 gallons of water. For swimming pools, add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools Chlorinating Solution per 10,000 gallons of water. For hot tubs, add 1/4 ounce of Sun Pools Chlorinating Solution per 1,000 gallons of water.

NOTE: The pH of the water should be between 7.2 and 7.6. If the pH is below 7.2, add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools pH Upper to each 10,000 gallons of water. If the pH is above 7.6, add 1/2 ounce of Sun Pools pH Down to each 10,000 gallons of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use if the container is damaged. Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not pour down the drain. Do not use if the container is empty.
