

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
**RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE**—For retail sale to end user. Not registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for use by persons under the direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the certified label. Always use with caution.

**DIP TREATMENT FOR PSOROPTIC MANGE MITES AND SARCOPTIC MANGE MITES**—For cattle, sheep and lambs. This product may be used for the treatment of psoroptic mange mites and sarcoptic mange mites in cattle and sheep. Accurately measure 3 pints of 10% concentrate to 120 gallons of water to give a 1665 ppm Toxaphene solution. Dipping animals.

From the holding pens, force animals through a chute into the dipping vat. An average dipping time for each animal to be immersed in the dipping solution is 15 minutes at least. After they leave the vat.

**REPLENISHMENT OF DIP SOLUTION IN VAT** When large numbers of animals have been dipped and the solution level in the vat has been lowered repeat the vat filling procedure. Add 30% of the measured amount of water and 10% Toxaphene to 120 gallons of water to give a 1665 ppm Toxaphene solution or more than needed to replenish the vat solution.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE block should appear at the top of the front panel (above the brand name). The minimum type size requirement for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" is the same as the minimum required for the front panel signal word.
2. Change the heading "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" to "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD".
3. Revise the first sentence of this section to read:

"This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife."

(Underscore added to indicate revisions and should not be reproduced on the labeling.)

Please submit an updated Confidential Statement of Formula.

Our records indicate that you have not submitted labeling in connection with the Toxaphene Cancellation Order. Your labeling has been reviewed in connection with that order and we have the following comment.

Add the following to the dip directions:

"Mixing of product should be conducted in a manner to maintain the percentage of toxaphene in the mixture at 0.5% for sheep and 0.6% for beef cattle."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 31, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
