DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE**—For retail sale to and use only by certified applicators or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the certified applicator's label.

DIP TREATMENT FOR PSOROPTIC MANGE MITES AND SARCOPTIC MANGE MITES—Beef, Cattle and Sheep. This product may be used for the control of Psoroptic and Sarcoptic mange mites on cattle and sheep. Dip concentrate. Accurately measure 3 pints of this concentrate and dilute with 120 gallons of water. This concentrate per 120 gallons of water will give a 1.66% toxaphene dip solution through which the dipping animals.

From the holding pens, force animals through a chute into the dipping vat. Allow at least 1 minute for each animal to be immersed in the dipping solution, touching the heads at least twice before they leave the vat.

REPLENISHMENT OF DIP SOLUTION IN VAT—When large numbers of animals have been dipped and the solution level in the vat has become low, replenish the vat solution by adding the measured amount of water and the required dip concentrate. For example, if the vat contains 100 gallons of water and the dip solution is 1.66% toxaphene, add 1.66 gallons of dip concentrate to the vat. Do not dilute more than needed to replenish the vat solution.

WARNING—Do not use this product on animals simultaneously with other dips or dips containing treatment with insecticides. Do not use this product on animals that are ill or that are about to be treated with any other dip. Do not use this product on animals that are about to be treated with any other dip.

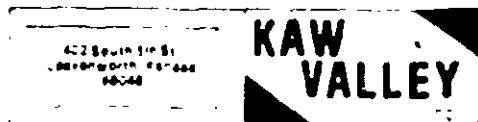

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE block should appear at the top of the front panel (above the brand name). The minimum type size requirement for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" is the same as the minimum required for the front panel signal word.
2. Change the heading "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZAROUS" to "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARUS".
3. Revise the first sentence of this section to read:

"This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife."

(Underscore added to indicate revisions and should not be reproduced on the labeling.)

Please submit an updated Confidential Statement of Formula.

Our records indicate that you have not submitted labeling in connection with the Toxaphene Cancellation Order. Your labeling has been reviewed in connection with that order and we have the following comment.

Add the following to the dip directions:

"Mixing of product should be conducted in a manner to maintain the percentage of toxaphene in the mixture at 0.5% for sheep and 0.6% for beef cattle."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until May 31, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.

1.5. Label or revise the product name "Stock-Tox Extra". In your letter and amendment application form you list "Tox-In Immissible Concentrate" as the product name. Please clarify. Names in product names such as "extra" are not acceptable. In your letter identify only one active ingredient in a product name such as "Stock-Tox". Product names with more than one active ingredient are unacceptable.

If you are shipping hazardous waste you must include the next label. The label is on page 14 of the form. It is attached to the bottom of the label of covered pipe.

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
