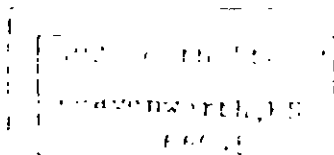

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.

PHYSICIAN'S NOTE: Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation which responds to barbituric acid derivatives. Prevent or control convulsions with barbiturates, preferable administered intravenously. If the barbiturates can be given before convulsions start, sodium phenobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a long-acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to "Clinical Handbook on Economic Poisons," which was prepared by the U. S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Georgia.

RIGHT PANEL

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
