d. Change "STATIONERY" to "STATIONARY."

e. Present the active ingredient as:

Dichlorovos: 2,2-Dichlorovinyl dimethyl phosphate.

f. Delete asterisk or provide a meaningful footnote.

g. The signal word "POISON" must appear in red on a background of distinctly contrasting color and the skull and crossbones must appear in immediate proximity to the word "POISON."

h. Correct the spelling of "mouth" in the If Swallowed section.

i. Add the word "artificial" before "respiration" in the If Inhaled section.

j. Revise:

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

k. Correct spelling of ANTIDOTE on front panel.

l. Move "DANGER: Contents under pressure, etc." to PHYSICAL or CHEMICAL HAZARDS.

m. Revise respirator requirements to read:

Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11.

n. Change "Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds" to "Do not apply directly to water."

o. Revise Pesticide Disposal to read:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or eyes. Do not get on skin. Do not breathe fumes. Rapidly absorbed through natural rubber gloves, waterproof protective clothing and when handling. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health for DDVP insecticide protection.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not throw container into fire or incinerator.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND ANTIDOTE STATEMENTS

POISON SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

TREATMENT: Atropine is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nervous stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, Atropine sulfate should be injected at 10 minute intervals, in doses of 1 to 2 mgs until complete Atropinization has occurred. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. Morphine is contra-indicated. Clear chest by postural drainage.

Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor.

Allow no further exposure until cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed, as determined by blood test.
