2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- e. In the ingredient statement, a colon should be inserted between Permethrin and its chemical name under the Active Ingredient heading. Also, in reference to the heading Inert Ingredient, the term "ingredient" should be spelled with an upper case "I."

3. Regarding your Confidential Statement of Formula the following comments apply:

- a. The lower certified limit for Permethrin cannot be the same as the nominal concentration. The upper and lower certified limits should bracket the nominal concentration and should be calculated in accordance with 40 CFR 158.175(b)(2).
- b. The lower certified limit for Polysorbate 20 and the upper certified limit for Mineral Oil cannot be the same as the nominal concentration specified under column 13b. These certified limits should bracket the nominal concentrations in accordance with 40 CFR 158.175(b)(2).

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## Controls lice and flies on cattle and keds on sheep

### Pour-on for beef, lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle and sheep

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product on a man

READY TO USE - NO DILUTION

#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pour along back line and down face. Apply one (1) fl. oz. per 100 lbs. maximum of 10 fl. oz. for any one animal to control Lice, Horn Flies, Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes, Black Flies, and Ticks on beef cattle, calves, and sheep. For Keds on sheep, pour along back. Apply 1/2 fl. oz. per 50 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 10 fl. oz.

Repeat treatment as needed, but not more than once every two weeks. Treatment at 14 day intervals is recommended.

NOTE: This product is not effective for grub control on cattle.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Storage: Keep container sealed when not in use. Do not store near heat. Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of in an approved waste disposal facility. Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or disposal in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or if allowed by State or local authority, burn in a controlled incinerator.
