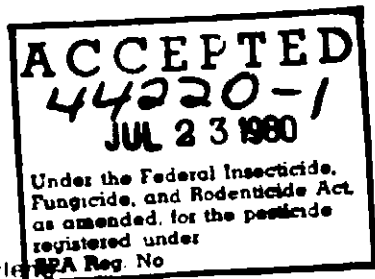

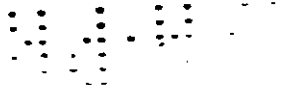
PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IWE 6030 P is used to control the growth of algae in exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness, spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using **IWE 6030 P**.

For spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of **IWE 6030 P** per 1,000 gallons of water.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of **IWE 6030 P** per 1,000 gallons of water.

To maintain spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of **IWE 6030 P** should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

IWE 6030 P is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. **IWE 6030 P** can be used in spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix **IWE 6030 P** with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

USE THIS LABEL FOR METAL CONTAINERS

STORAGE & DISPOSAL Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. The container must be triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or buried in a safe place. Rinseate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.
