It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IWE 6012 P is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using IWE 6012 P.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 71 to 109 fluid ounces of IWE 6012 P per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settle 3 algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 39 to 71 fluid ounces of IWE 6012 P per 10,000 gallons of water

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 13 to 26 fluid ounces of IWE 6012 P per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment

IWE 6012 P is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. IWE 6012 Picar be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix IWE 6012 P with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL Keep container closed when int in use. "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of container in an incinerator or in an approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. Rinsate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed. of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited
