DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IWE 6060 P is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness pools containing heavy algae growth should be cleaned prior to using **IWE 6060 P**.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of **IWE 6060 P** per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of **IWE 6060 P** per 10,000 gallons of water. To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 2 to 4 ounces of **IWE 6060 P** per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

IWE 6060 P is also used to control algae growth in exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. Spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy algae growth should be cleaned prior to using **IWE 6060 P**. For spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of **IWE 6060 P** per 1,000 gallons. For freshly cleaned and filled spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs add initially 0.6 to 1.1 fluid ounces of **IWE 6060 P** per 1,000 gallons of water. Maintenance dosages of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of **IWE 6060 P** should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

IWE 6060 P is compatible with chemicals normally used to treat pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. **IWE 6060 P** can be used in pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix **IWE 6060 P** with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. The container must be triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or buried in a safe place. Rinse that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.
