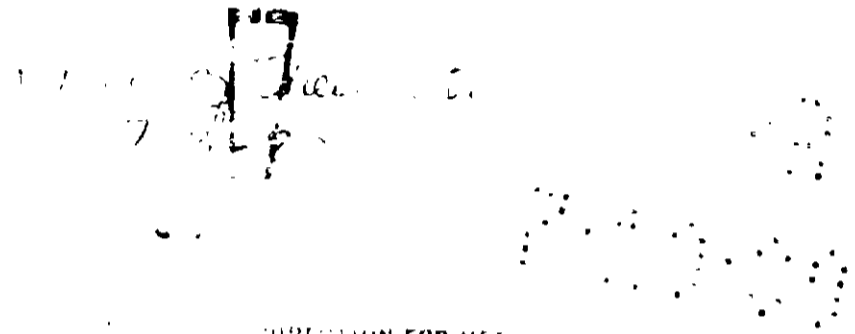

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION
 For every 10,000 gallons of water, add 1/2 ounce of SPARKLING CHLOR chlorinating solution for each 3300 gallon of water. This is the equivalent of 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE
 Test pool water pH to 7.6-7.8. Adjust manually if necessary. Add SPARKLING CHLOR chlorinating solution to maintain a residual chlorine level of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. Add 1/2 ounce of SPARKLING CHLOR chlorinating solution per 10,000 gallons of water. This will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Test water daily and adjust as needed.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit to determine the actual available chlorine level. Adjust accordingly to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

PRECAUTIONS AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large amounts of water. Rinse thoroughly with water and other regions to manufacture. Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not use in fish ponds or streams. Do not use in lakes or streams where fish are obtained for food. Do not use in streams where fish are obtained for food.
