Application Instructions

FOR POULTRY HOUSES:
Apply DARKLING BEETLE CONTROL dry with a duster uniformly at a rate of 2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. to soil surface when house is empty and after litter has been removed. When using as a spray, add 44 lbs. of DARKLING BEETLE CONTROL to 50 gallons of water (room temperature) and stir. Agitate until all powder is in solution. Apply solution uniformly at a rate of 2.25 gallons per 100 sq. ft. to soil surface when house is empty and after litter has been removed. Repeat application after each clean out. *

Note: In layer houses, saturate knee walls up to insulation.

Disposal

Do not reuse this container. Wrap and place in trash collector.
