

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tub effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use.

For pools having just visible algae growth add fluid ounces of MBC 130

to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools, add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of MBC 130 per 10,000 gallons should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially MBC 130 per 1,000 gallons of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of MBC 130 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. MBC 130 is used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with alkaline pH. MBC 130

decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag or other suitable container with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers.
