2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:


a. Add "EPA Registration No. 44392-8."

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tub effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of MBC 160 fluid ounces of MBC 160 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of MBC 160 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of MBC 160 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0 fluid ounces of MBC 160 per 1,000 gallons of water.

Subsequent additions of MBC 160 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. MBC 160 is compatible with pH adjusters used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains.

Decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals do not require the chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
